TO: THE CAMBRIDGE LICENSE BOARD

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, the residents, business people, and employees of businesses, all in the Central Square, Cambridge, Massachusetts, area, petition the Cambridge License Board to change the opening hours of all of the liquor establishments, both package stores and "pouring," from the present 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

The current situation in the Central Square area is extremely unpleasant, and unsafe, largely attributable to many alcoholics, who congregate and wait for the opening of these liquor establishments, at hours as early 6:30 a.m., trespass on our property, publicly urinate, quarrel, fight, and, in general, make the Central Square area an unattractive place in which to do business, shop, or walk. We believe that these limitations on the liquor establishment hours will greatly improve the atmosphere in this area, which has caused the rapid deterioration of property values, businesses, and has had an adverse impact upon those of us who live here, and, equally so, on those of us who make our living here. Your favorable consideration is hereby requested.

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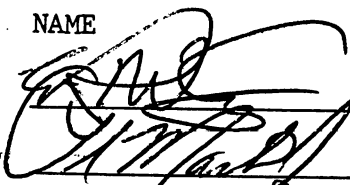
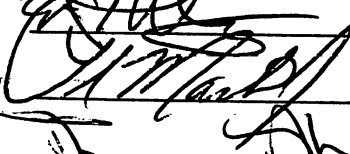
