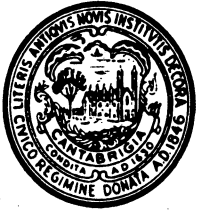
Re: **Posting of Tree Trimming Signs
on Chalk and Fairmont Streets.**

Please be advised that the Department of Public Works, Urban Forestry Division posted "No Parking" signs along Chalk Street in an attempt to prune all the public shade trees. However, due to circumstances beyond our control we were required to perform emergency work at another location in the City. It was our sincere desire to return to Chalk Street, as soon as possible, and not cause any disruption along the street.

Please understand that we need to post signage along streets to allow access to the shade trees or other utilities. Although our attempt fell short, we do apologize for any inconvenience we caused and hope that at the completion of our work you will be pleased and understand how difficult it is sometimes to get to our appointed locations.

I further resolve that if we are to place "No Parking" signs for work and are unable to get to your street or any other, we will pull the signs for that day and try again at another time.
