- WHEREAS: Numerous hardships arise daily on residents who live on streets that are lined with parking meters; and
- WHEREAS: These same residents, even though they have Resident Parking Permits on their cars, still are ticketed in front of their own homes unless they feed a meter all day which ends up costing them at least \$8 a day; and
- WHEREAS: Most of these residents are low or moderate income people who can least afford this expense; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager confer with the Head of the Traffic Department to see what can be done for the residents of these streets to alleviate this situation and report back to the City Council for the next meeting.
