Dear Mr. Healy,

On the evening of July 3, 1980 at 9:30 p.m. my daughter, a 16 year-old juvenile, along with three other juveniles and two 17 year-old adults, was arrested at Dana Park and charged with trespassing. They were transported by paddywagon and police car to the Cambridge Police station where three young women were frisked, deprived of their belongings, verbally abused and jailed awaiting release to the custody of their parents.

I was told, while accompanied by a witness, that the arrest was the result of an order by the City Council mandating an 8:30 p.m. curfew in the park, a statement which proved untrue.

Therefore, I request that this issue be placed before the City Council on the August 4 agenda.
