The City Council:

In compliance with the request contained in the order of the City Council on October 11, 1932, the arrangement under which the employees of the Recreation Division are working is outlined as follows:

One director is assigned to Cambridge Field daily from 9:30 to 5 o'clock and also on Sunday afternoons to cover the football and soccer games.

The two supervisors are assigned to visit nine of the other playgrounds, arranging for the entrusting of material to individuals in each locality and the repairing and replacing of such material. They also give some supervision to the Sunday games played on the athletic fields.
