That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Kinko's Copies for the erection of three retractable awnings at the premises numbered 907 Main Street, Cambridge.

Provided that, before erecting the above named awnings, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said awnings.

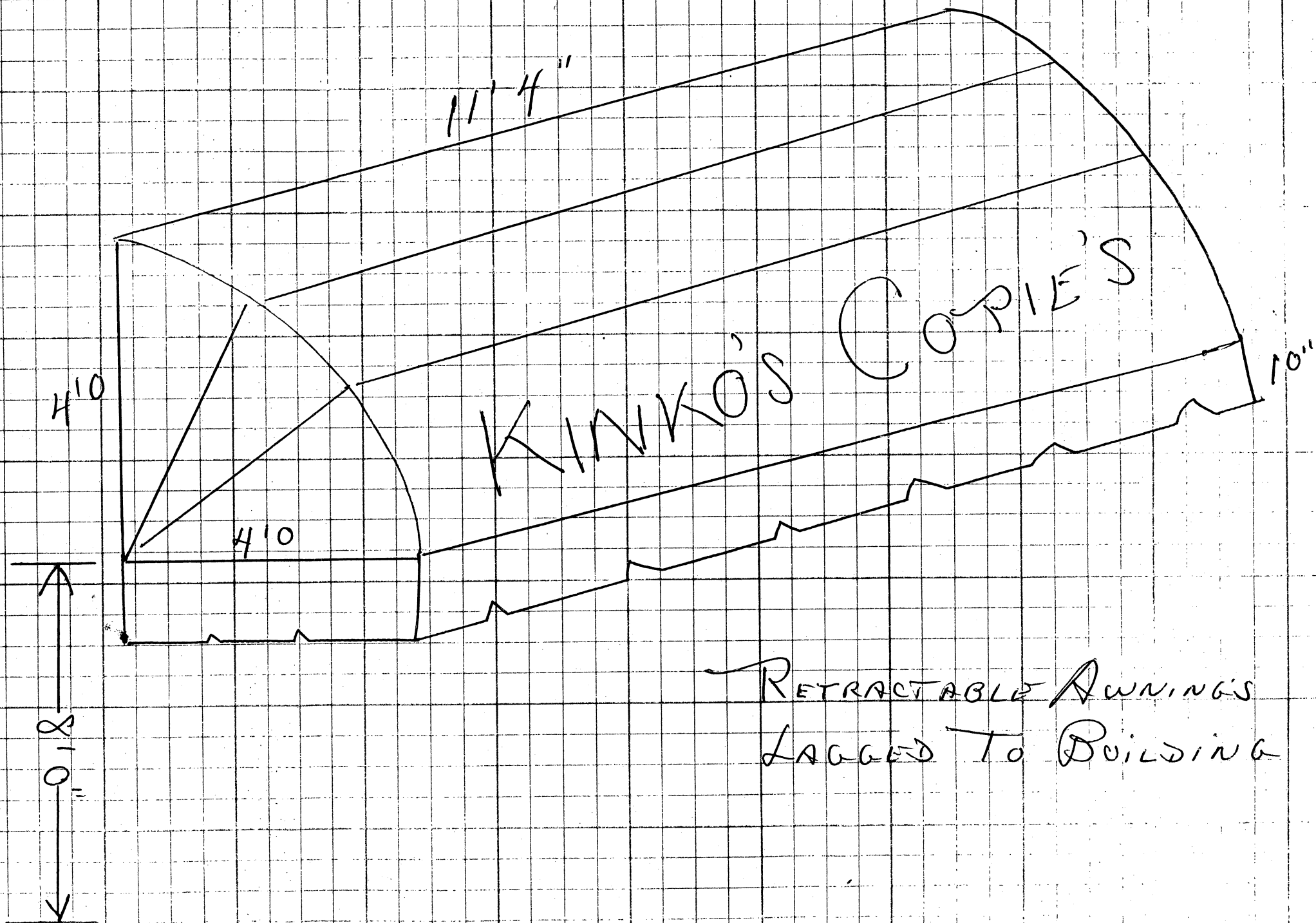
