## An Ordinance

In relation to the compensation of Policemen.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. From and after the first day in January, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, the compensation of Policemen shall be three dollars per day, payable monthly.

Sec. 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
