In accordance with Section 46 of Chapter 92 of the General Laws, I transmit herewith a copy of the order of the Metropolitan District Commission of November 20, 1974, granting to the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company location for approximately 230 feet of underground conduit and cable therein, in Mount Auburn Street, Cambridge, petitioned for by said Company on October 23, 1974. Said Section requires that said order shall be deposited in your office on or before December 2, 1974.

In Metropolitan District Commission
Boston, Mass., November 20, 1974

ORDERED that, on petition of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, dated October 23, 1974, for location shown on plan of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, dated February 13, 1974, and indexed accession number 48860X, in Mount Auburn Street, from a point, at the northeasterly side of Mount Auburn Street, then proceeding easterly approximately 150 feet of underground conduit and cable therein, to a point at Coolidge Avenue, then southerly 80 feet of underground conduit and cable therein, to the line of Coolidge Avenue and Mount Auburn Street on the southwesterly corner, Cambridge, to be used for the transmission of intelligence by electricity, said location being under the care and control of this Commission, and found by order of the Department of Public Utilities to be required by public convenience and necessity, said plan and petition being on file in the office of the Commission, a hearing on said petition having been given by this Commission on Wednesday, November 20, 1974, at 10:05 A.M., at the office of the Commission in Boston, of which hearing due notice was given to all persons interested of the time and place by publishing a copy of said petition and the order of notice issued thereon by this Commission in newspapers published in the City of Cambridge, being the city in which the location petitioned for would lie, the first publication having been made at least fourteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and it appearing, in the opinion of this Commission, that public convenience and necessity so require, said New England Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby granted a location for said underground conduit and cable therein, in said Mount Auburn Street, Cambridge, to the extent and upon the terms, conditions, and obligations hereinafter specified, the same being such as the public necessity and a due regard for the rights of the Commonwealth require, namely:-

1. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall conform to all provisions of law applicable to the exercise of the rights and performance of the work under this grant and to the rules and regulations of the Metropolitan District Commission.

2. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall do the work of installing said underground conduit and cable therein, in the location hereby granted subject to the approval of the Director of Park Engineering, and Chief Engineer - M.D.C., of the Commission,

as to time, manner, and location, and in all other respects.

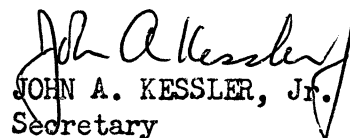
3. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Metropolitan District Commission from any damage it or they may sustain or be required to pay arising out of the exercise by said Company or any of its employees in connection with the work done hereunder.

4. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall protect and maintain all trees, drainage, or water pipes, and all appurtenances or structures either above or below the surface of the ground over which this location lies, and upon completion of the work shall restore the surface of the ground to the condition in which it was at the time of this grant, and in a manner satisfactory to said Director of Park Engineering, and Chief Engineer - M.D.C., of the Commission, and shall maintain the surface of the ground and the location throughout in such condition to the satisfaction of said Director, and Chief Engineer.

5. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall place and maintain proper barriers at all times and from the beginning of twilight through the whole of every night sufficient lights to protect the public from injury or damage during the progress of the work under this grant or during repairs upon said underground conduit and cable therein, and work on the location which may hereafter become necessary.

6. No work shall be done under this grant without first obtaining a permit therefor from said Director of Park Engineering, and subject to conditions imposed by him, and the Chief Engineer - M.D.C.
