WHEREAS:

An offer has been received by the City Council for the purchase of City owned land, with buildings thereon, situated on Reed Street, it is

ORDERED:

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized, in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge, to sell and convey to George Burke for the sum of Twenty-two Hundred Dollars (\$2200) a parcel of land situated and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Reed Street 261.95 feet more or less northerly from the northerly line of Rindge Avenue, thence northerly along the said easterly line of Reed Street 100 feet to a corner, thence easterly along land of now or formerly Ellen M. Norman 120 feet to a corner, thence southerly along land of now or formerly Margaret Lynch ux William J. Lynch and land of now or formerly William J. Lynch 100 feet, thence westerly along land of now or formerly Jeremiah Long 120 feet to a corner in the easterly line of Reed Street at the point of beginning. Containing 12,000 square feet more or less.

The above described parcel of land is shown on a plan entitled: "Public Property of the City of Cambridge" dated July 19, 1877 and on file in the office of the City Engineer of Cambridge, Public Property Volume 1, Page 21.
