It has come to the attention of this City Council that a Delegation of Ministry Officials from the People's Republic of China is presently visiting the United States; and

WHEREAS:

The Delegation, lead by Jiang Nanxiang, the Minister of Education in the People's Republic, is here for a seventeen day survey of current trends in education and education administration in America; and

WHEREAS:

Minister Nanxiang held a variety of administrative posts from 1949 to 1957 in the New Democratic Youth League and was elected as an alternate member of the Central Committee of the Chinese Communist Party in 1956; and

WHEREAS:

Minister Nanxiang is well suited for the position he holds, having served as President of Qinghua University from 1952 to 1961, where he lead a successful educational transition from a liberal arts institution to an engineering school and

WHEREAS:

Minister Nanxiang has steadfastly presided over the up-grading and the quality of the scientific education in Chinese universities; now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That I, Francis H. Duehay, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, hereby officially welcome Minister of Education Jiang Nanxiang and the entire Delegation of the People's Republic of China, to our city; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the Mayor and the members of the City Council.

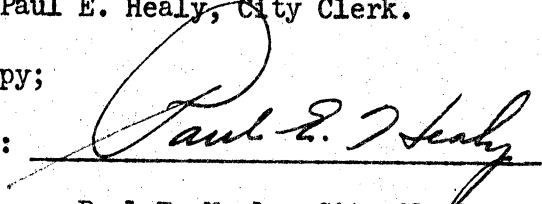
