ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Harvard/Radcliffe Hillel for the erection of a counterbalanced fire escape at the premises numbered 74 Mount Auburn Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named fire escape the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Forty-Five Thousand (\$45,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said fire escape.

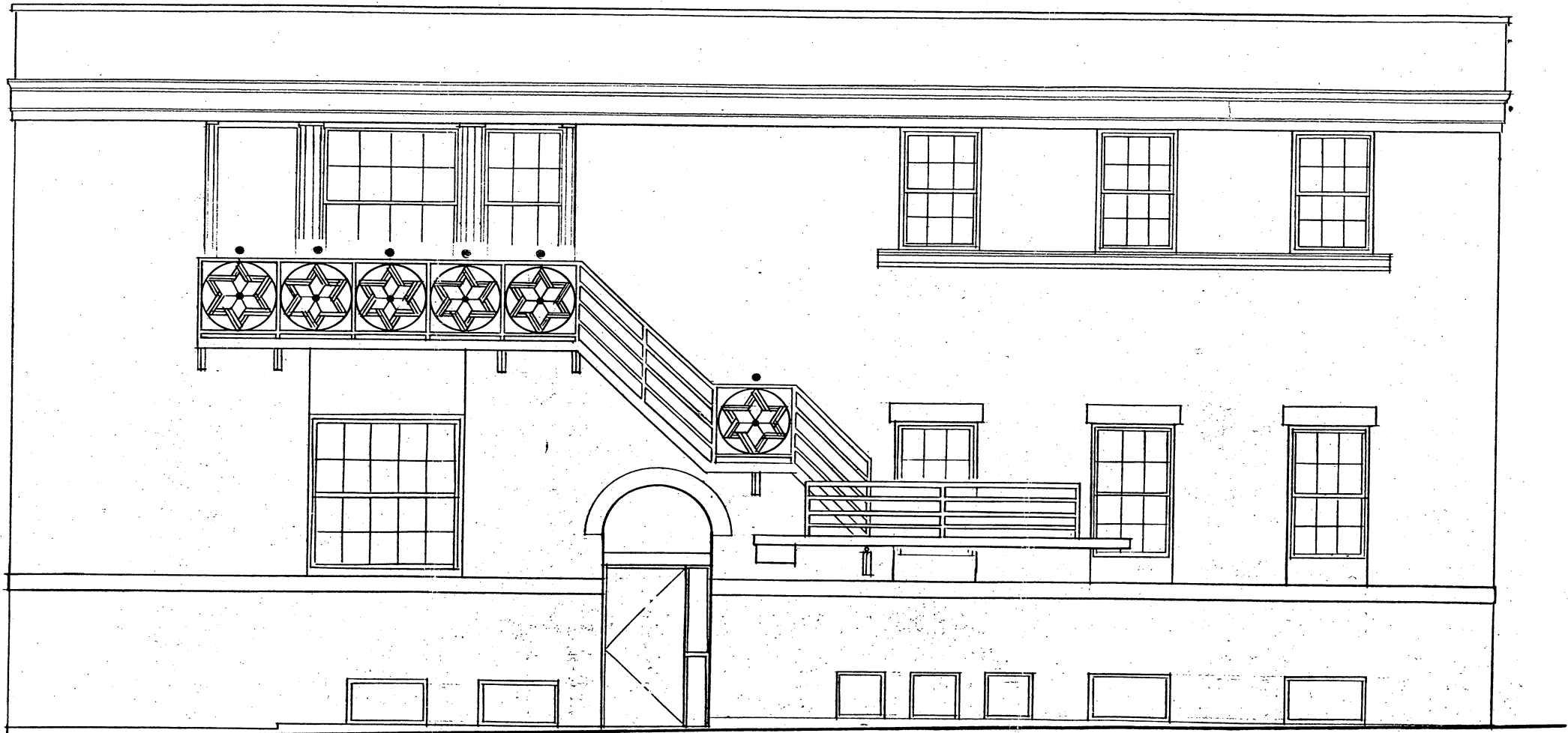
