

City of Cambridge.  
In the year one thousand eight  
hundred and fiftysix.

An Ordinance  
establishing the compensation of the  
City Treasurer and the Collector of  
Taxes.

Be it ordained by the City  
Council of the City of Cambridge, as  
follows:—

Section. 1. On and after the  
first Monday of January in the year  
one thousand eight hundred and  
fifty seven, the City Treasurer shall  
receive an annual salary of Three  
hundred dollars, to be paid in equal  
quarterly payments, and the Collector  
of Taxes shall receive the sum of seven  
hundred dollars, which shall be  
in full for his services in collecting  
the taxes assessed for the year in which  
he was chosen Collector, and all  
fees for summonses, warrants, and other  
services, received by him, shall be paid  
into the City Treasury.

Section. 2. All Ordinances,  
and parts of Ordinances, inconsistent  
herewith, are hereby repealed.
