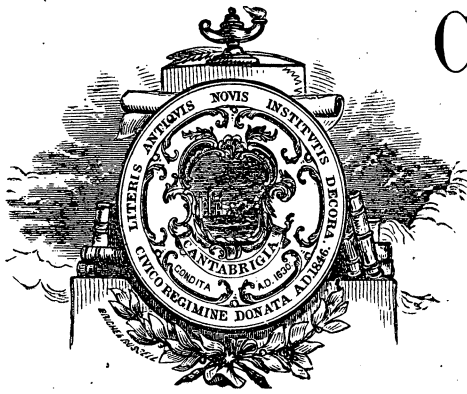




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

James Street, between Mason & Brattle Streets

widened
should be ~~laid out as a public Street~~. Ordered that a strip of land *about*
15 feet in width between

Mason and Brattle Streets,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J. S. Chase*
City Engineer

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
