To the Honorable, the City Council:

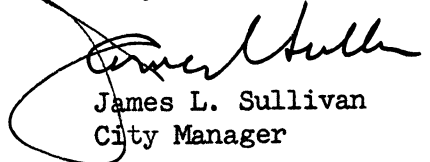
With respect to the City Council order regarding the implementation of Chapter 32, Sections 90A, 90C, and 90D, please be advised that no meeting ever took place on this item since the cost of full implementation of these sections would be too great for the City Budget to bear.

These sections were accepted during my last term as City Manager with a ceiling of \$3,500 or 1/2 whichever was less. The following year the limit was increased to \$4,000.

It is not reasonable to assume because of the abnormally high wages in Cambridge, that a patrolman who earned \$5,000 to \$6,000 while working should be entitled to \$7,000 per year while not working.

Therefore, due to the prohibitive cost of such a program, there will not be full implementation of Chapter 32, Sections 90A, 90C, and 90D.
