

 This Indenture of two parts, made this twenty-first day of October, in the

year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy, by and between the City of Cambridge, a body corporate duly established under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, of the first part, and Ezra J. Draper, of ^{Somerville} ~~Boston~~, and Richard K. Vaughan, of ^{Boston} ~~Somerville~~, Copartners and Bridge-builders, of the second part, **Witnesseth:** That the said Draper & Vaughan, in consideration of the promises and agreements of the said City of Cambridge, hereinafter contained, hereby promise and agree to and with the said City

of Cambridge that they will well and substantially rebuild so much of the Cambridge and Brookline Bridge, and of the Draw therey, as belongs to the City of Cambridge.

Said rebuilding is to be done in the same manner as that on the Brookline portion of said Bridge, by said Draper & Vaughan, with certain exceptions hereinafter mentioned.

The roadway is to be widened from four to six inches.

Suitable piles are to be driven for a stone abutment, to be built by and at the expense of said City.

The old hoisting-gear is to be used in the new Draw:—all other materials required in said rebuilding to be provided by said Draper & Vaughan.

The City is to have the right to take to its own use the plankings and any other of the old materials it may desire, but without expense or hindrance to said Draper & Vaughan.

All said work is to be performed under the direction and to the satisfaction of the Committee on Roads and Bridges of the City Council of said City, and to be completed on or before the first day of December next.

In consideration whereof, the said City of Cambridge hereby promises and agrees to and with the said *Draper & Vaughan*, that the said City shall and will well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, to the said *Draper & Vaughan* the sum of Five Thousand Dollars when said work shall have been completed as aforesaid.

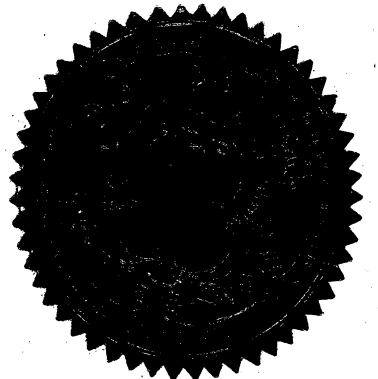
