- WHEREAS: Cornelia was known across the City for her wide range of political and civic activities; she was a founder of the Cambridge Civic Association, she was active in the United Way and its predecessor, the Cambridge Red Feather Association, and she was an active member of the First Parish Cambridge Unitarian and Universalist Church; and
- WHEREAS: Cornelia was the beloved wife of the late Leonard Wheeler; and
- WHEREAS: Cornelia's passing will leave a void in the lives of all her surviving family, her daughters, Penelope Pi-Sunyer, Cornelia Lanou, her sons, Leonard and John, her thirteen grandchildren and twenty great grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS: Cornelia will be sorely missed by all she touched and loved; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Cornelia Wheeler at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
