Ordered,

That a Special Committee, consisting of five members of the Common Council with such as the Board of Aldermen may join, be appointed to confer with a similar committee of the City Council of Cambridge, in reference to such action as it may be expedient to take under the provisions of Chapter 155 of the Acts of 1882, entitled "An act to authorize the cities of Boston and Cambridge to construct and maintain a bridge over Charles river," and that His Honor the Mayor be requested to act with said committee.

Hathorne and Oakman were appointed on said committee. Came up for concurrence. Concurred and Aldermen Curtis, Smith & Mullane were joined. Approved by the Mayor, Jan. 20, 1885.
