

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight-Hundred and Sixty-four,

An Ordinance

in relation to the construction and repairs of Reservoirs and Hydrants.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sec. 1. The Ordinance in relation to the duties of the Engineers of the Fire Department, passed March 9, 1864, is amended by striking out the words "as well as the Engines and other Fire Apparatus," and adding the words, "but it shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Streets and Drains to have charge of their construction, and make such repairs as may require the breaking up of streets or sidewalks."
