- WHEREAS: Since Council Order No. 10 of February 10, 1986, the Community Development Department has been working with the property owner and the MBTA to provide a bus shelter at Brookline and Erie Streets for elderly residents of the L.B.J. Apartments, who must now wait in the open air; and
- WHEREAS: By letter of June 26, 1986, the M.B.T.A. has refused to provide such a bus shelter, even though the property owner is now willing; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to take all steps necessary to secure such a bus station, if necessary at city expense, or by obtaining a shelter no longer needed by the MBTA; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report his progress in this matter to the City Council as soon as possible.
