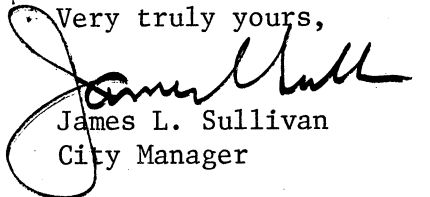

With respect to City Council Order #15 of February 27, 1978, please be advised that the prior City Council passed an order to name the East Cambridge Fire Station after the Carvalho brothers.
