Subject: City Council Order # 39, dated 4/11/94

Any rules or regulations pertaining to ambulance service is contained in the Code of Massachusetts Regulations 105 CMR 170.000.

Specifically, 105 CMR 170.360: Ambulance Identification states

(b) Each certified ambulance shall be equipped with emergency warning lights and audible warning devices as provided for in the class for which the vehicle is certified.

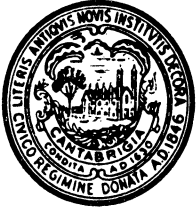
(c) The use of emergency warning lights and/or audible warning devices is permitted only as needed when an ambulance is on a call for the purpose of hospitalizing a sick or injured person or at the scene or en route to the scene of a critical or unknown illness or injury.
