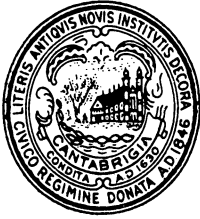


To the Honorable, the City Council,

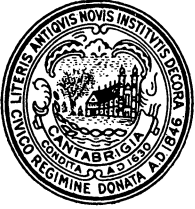
To provide reimbursement as follows:
