Milt Hinton, 96 was jazz bassist

NEW YORK — Milt Hinton, jazz bassist and photog known as "the judge" by legends he worked with as photographed during a 70-year career, died Tuesday. He was

Considered the dean of players, Mr. Hinton performed with almost every lumina and popular music, from Armstrong, Cab Calloway, Gillespie, and John Coltrane. Bing Crosby, Frank Sinatra, Streisand, and Paul

Mr. Hinton also documented his world with a camera, taking close to 60,000 negative pictures of hundreds of jazz and popular musicians on the road, in the studio, backstage at parties. His photos have exhibited around the world

But it is the film footage of his wife, Mona, shot as photographer Art Kane gathered blues greats in 1959 for a — known today as "A Great Harlem" — that may be his most recognizable work.

Mr. Hinton began his career playing the vibraphone, switched to bass because he could find more work.

After years of playing around Chicago as a freelance musician, Mr. Hinton joined Calloway's band in 1936. His 15-year stint with Calloway's band was also featured on dozens of recordings with Goodman, Lionel Hampton, Hawkins, and Billie Holiday among others.

When Mr. Hinton joined Calloway's band in the 1950s, he moved to New York and continued to work as a session musician. For the next 20 years he played on thousands of popular music albums, jazz and film soundtracks.

Mr. Hinton's collection of photographs has been featured in books, "Bass Line: The Story of Milt Hinton," and "The Judge: A Life in Jazz."
