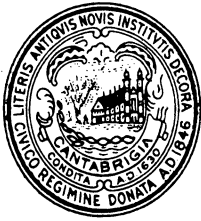

SUBJECT: Appropriation from Parking Fund

With respect to my request for a transfer of \$15,000 from the Parking Fund to the Planning and Development Department's A-2, Temporary Personnel account, I am pleased to provide the following additional information.

The funds requested are for salaries of staff in the Planning and Development Department who work on parking studies, and supervision of work performed by consultants working on parking garages. The money needed for the Department's use is not a duplication of the funds previously appropriated to the Executive Department schedule F-29, Harvard Square Parking Studies. That money which is handled by the City Manager's office is for the retention of engineers, architects, and other consultants and could not be used to pay staff salaries of the Planning and Development Department. The relationship between the two is that the Department is responsible for preparing and justifying proposals for parking garages in Harvard Square and works in conjunction with engineers, architects, soils consultants and financial consultants, who are paid with the F-29 funds by the City Manager. Although both funds are used for the objective of constructing public parking facilities in Harvard Square, they are separate, and cannot be used interchangeably.

Essentially the same relationship exists between the Department personnel working on the Green-Franklin parking garage in Central Square and the Executive Department schedule F-31, Green-Franklin Street parking.


