Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in Tariff M.D.P.U. No. 3 filed with the Department on May 22, 1973 to become effective on July 1, 1973, by Trombly Motor Coach Service, Inc.

The Company having filed the Tariff referred to above, this Department suspended the operation of the rates and charges set forth therein pending study and investigation of their propriety. The proposed rate increase would, if approved, raise additional annual revenues of approximately \$30,000. The Department, having completed its preliminary investigation, will hold a public hearing as to the propriety of the proposed rates and charges at its hearing-room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts, on Thursday, July 26, 1973, at 11:00 o'clock in the forenoon.
