IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Rosie's Pastries for the erection of a sign at the premises numbered 243 Hampshire Street.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

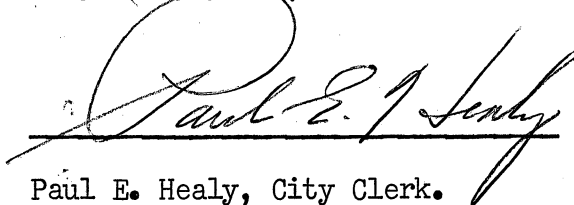
