I am writing in regards to an intersection in Cambridge that I feel needs a stop sign. I drive, walk, take the bus, and sometimes bike through this intersection, only to be stopped at my stop sign when the street I am trying to cross has no stop sign but rather many cars passing without a break.

I am talk about The intersection of Mass Ave./Harvard St. and Bow Street. Both Bow St. and Harvard St. have stop signs going onto Mass. Ave. Yet, Mass Ave does not.
