To whom it may concern:

I am writing from CASA (Central America Solidarity Association) to ask permission to set up a table in front of the post office at Central Square, on Saturday June 26, 1993 for our summer campaign to tell the truth about US involvement in El Salvador. CASA is a non-profit grassroots organization working for peace and justice in Central America, and in US government policy towards the countries there..

The purpose of our campaign is to collect signatures (see enclosed postcard) to present to legislators at the end of the summer. The specific goals of our campaign are to:

- 1. End military aid to El Salvador.
- 2. Condition economic aid on the firing of death squad commanders and full compliance with the rest of the Salvadoran peace accords.
- 3. Fully investigate the role of the US government in El Salvador's war.
- 4. Oppose any amnesty before the recommendations of the truth commission are carried out.
- 5. -channel development assistance to support reconciliation to programs such as the national civilian police and land reform.

We will provide our own table and will be at the above location between the hours of 11am and 3pm.
