WHEREAS: The City Manager issued a report that urged the repeal of the Cambridge Jobs and Residency Ordinance two years ago; and

WHEREAS: In that report, the Personnel Director cited as one of the chief reasons for repeal, a non-resident applicant for the position of Director of Workforce Development as being so well qualified and by far the best candidate for the job that excluding this person would not be in the best interests of the city; and

WHEREAS: The ordinance was repealed and the person referenced in the report was subsequently hired by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS: Only eighteen months later, this person has left the job and a search is underway for a new Director of Workforce Development when a Cambridge resident might be willing to make a greater commitment to the City; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to give every consideration to Cambridge residents or to applicants willing to relocate to Cambridge in the search for a candidate to fill the position of Director of Workforce Development.
