It is ordained by the City Council of  
Cambridge as follows -

The "Ordinance providing for the appoint-  
ment of a City Solicitor and prescribing  
his duties" is hereby amended by the  
addition to Section Three thereof, of the  
following words, "and all opinions so  
furnished by him, and having reference  
to matters of general public interest, shall  
be printed annually, with the docu-  
ments usually so printed under the di-  
rection of the City Clerk, by Order of the  
City Council."
