To the Honorable, the City Council:

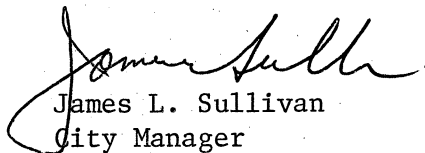
I am pleased to present you with a copy of the Fresh Pond Reservation Master Plan, prepared for the Fresh Pond Task Force and the Community Development Department. Inserted in the Master Plan is a list of the Task Force's high priority recommendations.

The Cambridge Water Board has reviewed the Master Plan and endorses its findings and recommendations. Furthermore, the Water Board recommends that all implementation work relating to the Water Department functions or to water quality be funded from the Water Department Budget.

I have reviewed the Master Plan with David Vickery, Assistant City Manager for Community Development.
