Subject Council Order #6 April 13, 1987 At Intersection of Channing St. and Mt. Auburn St.

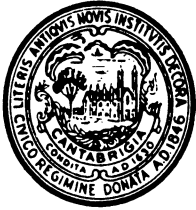
During the fall of 1986, signs were installed along both sides of Channing Street restricting parking within 30 feet of Mt. Auburn Street. On the north side of Mt. Auburn Street there is a hydrant west of Channing Street which restricts parking for about 40 feet from the intersection.

East of Channing Street we will install a No Stopping sign on the existing sign pole about 40 feet before the street. This along with good enforcement will help drivers to safely enter/exit Channing Street.

During my investigation I did notice that the line of evergreens along the property line of Mt. Auburn Street did limit the sight line for vehicles coming from Harvard Square.
