WHEREAS:-

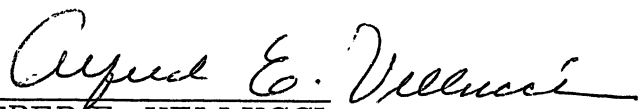
Each of us in his or her own way has the opportunity to help to guarantee that our air will be cleaner; and so now therefore be it

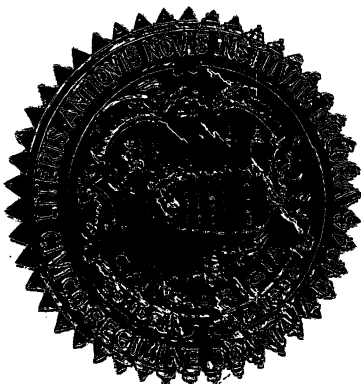
RESOLVED:-
