- WHEREAS: The land on which the present temporary structure sits is owned by MIT; and
- WHEREAS: MIT's development plans threaten the existence of this center because it has no place to move; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to intensify discussions with MIT to donate land at the present location which is ideal for this purpose; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby be requested to report his progress on this matter at the earliest possible time.
