IN CITY COUNCIL
October 3, 1983

- WHEREAS: The current composition of boards and commissions in the City of Cambridge does not fully represent the talent and diversity of the city; and
- WHEREAS: Members of one board or commission may be, and are, appointed to other boards and commissions; and
- WHEREAS: The membership of a number of Cambridge boards and commissions includes individuals who have served for long periods; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That it shall be the policy of the City of Cambridge:
1. to appoint more working class, minority, and low-income people to the city's boards and commissions;
 2. to limit terms of board and commission members to no more than three (3) years, or as provided by law;
 3. not to appoint an individual already serving on a Cambridge board or commission to a second board or commission of the city if the term of the first appointment and the term of the second appointment overlap more than six (6) months;
- and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager and/or the City Solicitor are hereby requested to determine the specific steps required to carry out this policy for each of the city's boards and commissions and to report back to this City Council on or before October 17, 1983; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That in the specific case of the Rent Control Board, the City Manager is hereby requested to implement immediately the recommendation of the Mayor's Commission on Rent Control and limit the terms of Rent Control Board members to no more than three (3) years.
