Pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and from the W.P.A. Sponsor monthly reports for the month of April.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases three less than at the end of March, and on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children fifty-eight cases less than at the end of March. These classes of cases cost the City \$115,569.98 during the month of April, a decrease of \$3,210.18 as against the month of March.

The Sponsor's Agent reports one thousand and eighty-two persons employed during the month of April on W.P.A. projects, a decrease of one hundred and twenty-eight from the previous month. The cost for April was \$12,398.83 to the City, an increase of \$1,363.99, and \$94,611.88 to the Federal Government, a decrease of \$1,011.30. The increased cost to the City was represented largely by Park and Sewer Projects. Nine State-wide Projects and one Federal Agency Project were discontinued during April. New State-wide Projects for Americanization, Adult Education, Music, and Soldiers Home and a Project at the Chelsea Naval Hospital were taken on. Fifty-seven new persons were taken on from Welfare rolls, and one hundred thirty-two persons were graduated to private employment and the new In-Plant training program.
