

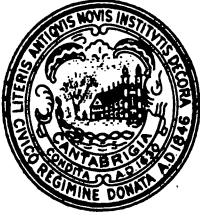



To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to announce to the City Council that the City of Cambridge has received grant awards totalling \$1,822,000.00 from the second round of funding under the terms and provisions of the Public Works Capital Development and Investment Act of 1976. These funds will be used to rehabilitate the Public Works Garage, Municipal Building (Police Headquarters), City Hall and City Hall Annex, Main Library, Inman Square and Taylor Square Fire Stations, and the Nurses' Residence building at the Cambridge Hospital. In addition, these grant funds will allow us to disappropriate \$30,000 in tax-supported funds originally appropriated for "Renovation of the City Hall Annex" before this grant program was enacted by Congress.

Passage of the attached orders is recommended.
