

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, May, 19th 1869.

Ordered: that the Superintendent of Streets be directed to complete the sidewalks on both sides of North Avenue commencing on the Easterly side at Holmes Place, and on the Westerly side at Waterhouse St, and ending at the Railroad Bridge by setting edgstones and to lay stone crossings across the intervening streets; the expense to be charged to the appropriation for Streets & Paving and assessed according to law.
