To the Honorable Members of the City Council:

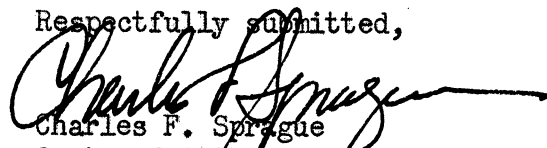
Re: Petition of Mrs. Margaret Spera and others concerning the noise of trucks parked in the rear of the Arco Gas Station at 239 Msgr. O'Brien Highway.

This is to inform you that Building Inspector, Vincent L. Kelley, investigated conditions on the lot on March 30, 1971 and was informed by the manager of the Gas station that they have a license for parking twenty (20) cars. On site were two (2) disposal trucks, a moving van, three (3) Hertz trailers, two (2) Hertz trucks. The station manager states the two (2) disposal trucks are started at 6:15 A.M. and are off the lot at 6:20 A.M.

A check of the Zoning map indicates that the lot is in an Industry-B Zone in which a trucking terminal is allowed under Article IV, Section 2, Paragraph 8f, Table of Use Regulations of the Cambridge Zoning Ordinance.

The matter has been referred to the Cambridge License Commission for whatever action is deemed necessary.
