WHEREAS: One of the most basic and important services the City provides to its residents is water; and

WHEREAS: The underground system of pipes and sewers are vast and connect to privately owned pipes; and

WHEREAS: When residents have problems with the water, our water department should act immediately to verify the cause of the problem, and provide substantiating evidence; and

WHEREAS: The Rush A.M.E. Church, located at 82 School Street has had problems with its water for the last six months. Their plumbers have installed new pipes, but the church is still experiencing serious clogging problems; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the water department officials to assist the Rush A.M.E. Church by verifying the cause of the clogged pipes, and by factually determining whether it is the responsibility of the owner or the water department to fix the pipes.
