- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately appoint a committee of three persons, namely the City Solicitor, Custodian of Foreclosed Property and the Assistant City Manager for Administration, to investigate the future closing of the Chester Manor Nursing Home and the Exeter Nursing Home in order that the City of Cambridge will be fully aware of this situation and be prepared to offer any assistance necessary to the patients within these nursing homes; and be it further
- ORDERED: That this committee review the possibility of the City taking over both administrations of these homes either on a temporary or permanent basis to ensure that no patient is left without a proper facility in which to live; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council within two weeks the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
