COUNCILLOR CLEM

ORDERED: That it is the policy of this City Council, and the City Manager is hereby requested, to inform the License Commission to temporarily suspend enforcement of the "brown bagging" regulation against those holders of common victualler licenses that meet the following conditions:

1. Restaurants that serve food only and do not derive income from entertainment or cover charges;
2. Restaurants that provide sanitized glassware and decorking devices for their patrons;
3. Restaurants that provide table service to patrons by waiters and waitresses;
4. Restaurants that wish to permit patrons to bring wine or beer onto their premises.

This suspension shall remain in effect until the License Commission has reported to the City Council on the results of the study requested by the Council on June 27, 1977.
