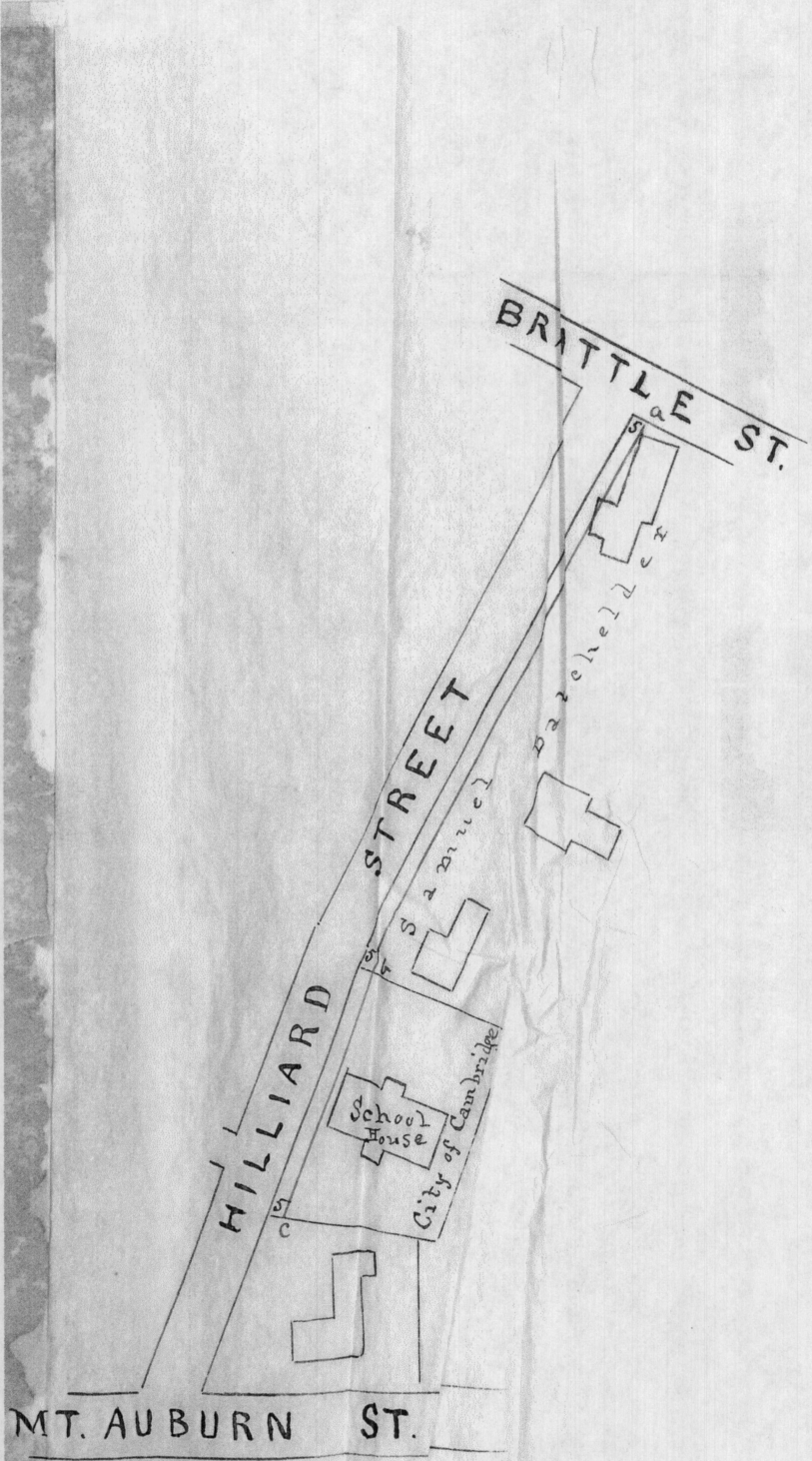

Cambridge, June 30, 1886.

To the Honorable, the Mayor, and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge.

The undersigned respectfully prays
that a sidewalk five feet wide may be laid out and estab-
lished by said City on the Easterly side of Hilliard Street
in said Cambridge, extending from Brattle Street to the
Southernly line of the Holmes School House lot on said Hilliard
street, as shown by the red line "a b c" on the annexed sketch.

And your petitioner hereby indicates his readiness, in
case the prayer of this petition shall be granted, to dedicate to
public use for a sidewalk as aforesaid, a strip of land five feet
wide between said points "a" and "b", provided that the cost of
such laying out ^{and of maintaining such sidewalk} and establishment be wholly defrayed by said City.
