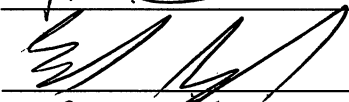

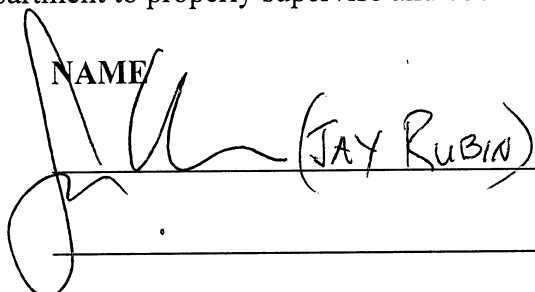
PETITION

We, the undersigned, believe that the sewer construction in our neighborhoods has caused an unnecessary amount of disruption and inconvenience. We believe that ~~there has been~~ the City has failed to coordinate the contractors' activities to minimize the impact of the work. We have repeatedly experienced such problems as streets being unnecessarily posted with no parking signs even when work was not being done, noisy work occurring too early in the morning, streets being torn up and not repaved for extended periods of time, or work being done poorly. We believe that the work has been scheduled and done without proper regard for the needs of residents who lived in the affected area. We believe that lessons learned from the experience in our neighborhood can prevent the same problems from occurring in other neighborhoods of this city. We request that the City Council convene a hearing at which the public can speak, into the activities of the contractor and into the failure of the City Public Works Department to properly supervise and coordinate the contractors' activities.
