COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: It has come to my knowledge that in these times of enormous, intense financial stress and fiscal tightness, when the Police Academy has been cancelled and shut down and the blade of the budget axe inches steadily toward cutting back and/or cutting out essential social agencies and programs, thereby placing the health, safety and welfare of Cambridge residents in jeopardy, in the fact of all of this, the City of Cambridge has allowed one city department to sue another agency within the city government and has approved the hiring of outside legal counsel for this litigation; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council and specify:

- what the core issue of the litigation is;
- what city departments/agencies are involved as parties thereto;
- the identity(ies) of all outside legal counsel engaged for this litigation;
- the total cost and method of billing for the services of said counsel; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide this information within one week.
