- WHEREAS: Dr. Hester served his country during World War II as a Medical Officer in the United States Army from 1942 to 1945; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Hester has long been an active member of St. Peter's Parish where he has been involved in several charitable projects through the years, always making himself available to those in need; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Dr. James Hester for his loyalty and dedication and to further extend every good wish for health and happiness for the future; and be it further
