- WHEREAS: Many Harvard Square merchants are currently displaying merchandise on the sidewalk in violation of city ordinances, especially on Saturdays; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be empowered to meet with Harvard Square merchants, to consult surrounding neighborhood associations and arrive at a set of regulations which the Police Department shall without fail enforce, which allows some limited and uniform access to the sidewalk for those wishing to display merchandise or to set up outside tables for eating; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager shall monitor the effectiveness of this new program during the summer and shall report to the City Council in September whether existing ordinances governing these matters should be permanently changed.
