Per telephone conversation with John McKinnon, Office Dispatcher, who expalined that the Cambridge Police Department has informed the company in writing of the violations involved.

All disposal truck operators have been notified in writing not to pick-up refuse in the City of Cambridge before 7:00 a.m. according to law.

On site visit revealed one 2yd dumpster container in rear yard entrance area. Met with Security Guard Jeff, who stated that refuse is picked up 5 times a week, Monday through Friday.

The 2yd container does not abutt residential property. Conditions on this inspection were found satisfactory.

This department will continue to monitor this problem.

Last week a Reliable garbage truck arrived at the 7 Ware Street
New England Telephone/ Harvard Center in Cambridge, Mass
at 9610 am and proceeded to wake up the whole neighborhood.

As usual it backed down Trowbridge Place (A PRIVATE STREET)
with gears grinding and motor roaring. It had the back-up
beeper turned OFF which may be a violation of law and is cer-
tainly a violation of safety...trying, no doubt, to sneak in.

At the NET building the banging was about 90 decibels.

The truck then pulled out slowly, more whining gears and grinding
motor, and STOPPED at Trowbridge Street corner for 6 minutes.
???? Ahead of schedule; breakfast...???? In any event the motor
waked up those sleeping within 20 feet who had missed the grand
banging at the dumpster. Your dispatcher said, "not my job!"

The Cambridge city code forbids such noise at that hour and
owners of the private street are ready to go to court.

The next time it happens a car may block the truck exiting the
private street until the police arrive. This is serious.

The driver is perhaps given a too heavy schedule so he comes before
it is legal. It has been happening for years but worse lately.

Or he is given too light a schedule and is trying to get done
soonest.

Whatever: he and Reliable are breaking the law, and NET/EU are
bad neighbors. All this noise for one tiny bin holding little trash.

You are unconcerned about sleeping babies, mothers, and people
who work. You don't give a damn about laws.

BEHIND EVERY RUDY EMPLOYEE STANDS AN APATHETIC MANAGER.

Don't call; don't write. Just be good neighbors: legal and quiet.
