A section of public sidewalk (the southern side of Massachusetts Avenue from 1000 down to the other side of A & P Supermarket) is in terrible shape; large sections missing bricks, of uneven height, and definitely constituent of health and 'other' hazards. I personally witnessed an elderly lady, whom I did ^{not} know, take a bad spill across the street from the Orson Welles Theater in front of 1000 Mass. Ave. and upon noticing how she was in pain, as a result of this hazard, decided to report it to the proper authorities. I recommend hardtopping the entire stretch after it has been topographically levelled.
