To the City Councillors:

I strongly oppose the application for a curb cut behind 407A/409 Broadway. I live at 51 Dana Street and feel the curb cut would adversely affect the neighborhood.

It is already hard to find parking on that block. Taking away another space would increase this problem.

Up and down the street gardens have been eliminated for parking spaces. Putting in the curb cut would mean yet another parking space instead of the owners making a garden, something enhancing the neighborhood.

Cars already zoom up and down the alley behind my apartment, connecting with Broadway. This curb cut would increase this traffic by making yet another alleyway accessible - more noise and more hazards.

Finally, cars pulling out of the newly created parking space on to Dana Street would block traffic on what is a heavily travelled street, creating more dangers for residents.
